We have had a fun and busy half term in Robins! The year one children have settled back into school with ease and have been fantastic role models for our new reception children. Thank you, year one! Reception have settled very well into school and are so keen to discover and find out more everyday. I am very proud of them all and their fantastic attitude to learning!

During this half term, Reception have been looking at the core text 'The Lion Inside'. They have talked about how the story makes them feel, traced words from the text and created their own lion pictures, complete with a tissue paper mane! Reception have now learnt 18 new sounds - they are so excited for their phonics session each day and are starting to make words using magnetic letters.

Year one have recently been exploring the key text 'Wild'. They have been learning about 'bossy verbs' and have put these into practice by writing a set of instructions for if a new child were to start in our class. In Maths, they have been looking at addition and subtraction to 10, using number lines, manipulatives and whiteboards to help them.

Robins have been making the most of the lovely weather this half term and have been outside lots, on the trikes and in our outdoor area. They have had fun digging, playing in the mud kitchen and in the sandpit.

The children thoroughly enjoyed practising the songs and prayers for our Harvest Festival, which was a joy to watch.

Covid Vaccines for 5-17 year olds

COVID vaccines: how to access first or second doses for children aged 5-17

It isn't too late for children to access a COVID vaccination if they haven't already completed their course.

Children are eligible for:

- First or second dose Children aged 5 to 11 (paediatric dose Pfizer)
- First or second doses Children aged 12-17 (Pfizer)
- Third primary dose Children aged 5-11 who are severely immunocompromised (paediatric dose Pfizer – 8 weeks after second dose), anyone aged 12+ who is severely immunocompromised (Pfizer – 8 weeks after second dose)
- Autumn booster Children aged 5-11 who are severely immunocompromised or household contact of someone immunocompromised (paediatric dose Pfizer – at least 3 months after previous dose), anyone aged 12-17 who is severely immunocompromised or household contact of someone immunocompromised (Pfizer – at least 3 months after previous dose)

*children aged 5-15 inclusive must wait 12 weeks after a COVID-19 infection to get a vaccination

**people aged 16 or over must wait four weeks after a COVID-19 infection to get a vaccination

To access a vaccination, contact your GP Practice for advice on how to book an appointment at a local vaccination centre, use the national booking system to get an appointment at a community pharmacy or the JabVan at Gloucestershire Royal Hospital (<u>www.nhs.uk/covidvaccination</u> or call 119), or look out for drop-in clinics on the <u>local COVID information portal</u>.

Please make sure to carefully check eligibility before taking your child to a drop-in clinic; depending on their age they may only have specific vaccines which will not always be available at every clinic.
