Below are a list of ideas for your child to investigate about how children's lives have changed. If they wish to share the results of these investigations in school, that would be most welcomes.

Art Create two pictures showing a child's life in the past and a child's life today. You could draw, paint or make a collage.	Geography Compare your local area with what it may have looked like when your grandparents were children. Create a simple map and label things that have changed.	DT Design and make a toy that could have been played with 100 years ago. You could use recyclable materials.
History Interview an older family member about their childhood. Create a fact file showing similarities and differences between their childhood and yours.	RE Create an information poster about a Jewish festival such as Hanukkah, Passover or Rosh Hashanah. Explain what the festival teaches Jewish people about what is important to them.	Science Create a poster, model or labelled diagram showing the journey food takes through the digestive system. Label the main organs and explain what happens at each stage.
