Speedwell class


Speedwell are working hard and having fun honing their maths skills. We sometimes like to investigate numbers and travel far into Deep Maths! This week we got very

Using the theme of recycle, reuse and reduce we would like children to **make their own costumes** and **bring the book their chosen character is from** to talk about over the day.




